





SBSP has the honor of being the hosting society for EMOPXII in Turku, Finland, July 2016. The organizing committee calls for interested volunteers to contact the head organizer Antti Oksanen. (Pikka Jokelainen & Brian Lassen)

Proposal of reforming the membership payment system.

The board has discussed the following changes for approval to reduce management of memberships and making payment more flexible:

- 1. Collecting SBSP finances to one account to reduce management expenses;
